Please note, we recently learned that the Department of Commerce liquor buyback is no longer a one-time buyback. Below is updated information.

Liquor Buyback:

The Ohio Department of Commerce will immediately begin offering a liquor buyback option to support bars and restaurants. This will especially aid those establishments that have stocked up on high-proof liquor but now cannot serve it due to their closure to inhouse patrons.

Bars and restaurants wishing to take advantage of this opportunity should return their unopened, high-proof liquor products (obtained within the past 30 days) to the agency where they purchased the product. This opportunity is also extended to those with temporary (F2) permits for events scheduled between March 12 and April 6, 2020.
